

Geography Curriculum

Intent:

Geography is essentially about understanding the world we live in. It helps to provoke and provide answers to questions about the natural and human aspects of the world. At BGN our students are encouraged to develop a greater understanding and knowledge of the world, as well as their place in it.

Implementation:

Students study a range of topics from Physical Geography, Human Geography & Environmental Geography during each academic year. Some of these topics interlink & cross over during the course of a year and allow a deeper development of skills (e.g. data presentation & analysis, photo interpretation, statistical analysis) and an appreciation of how the different aspects of geography compliment each other.
