Dear Year 13 Students and Parent/Carers

In order to support you to prepare for your final exams, we would like to offer you the opportunity to select up to five study periods over the two week timetable in which you can undertake independent study at home. Our expectation is that this time is used for focused research, writing or revision and is not seen to be as 'free time'. You can nominate up to five such periods which you must agree with your tutors. Before you can consider applying for a privilege pass you must ensure that you are completely up to date with your EPQ. Passes will only be authorised if your EPQ teacher has signed your application.

We also require that you have the agreement of your Parents/Carers and request that you must complete the form on the reverse which should be returned to form tutors to be confirmed. Please note that this 'privilege pass' is a privilege and not a right. It may be refused or withdrawn if subject teachers feel that you do not benefit from working at home.

If you wish to apply for a 'privilege pass', please complete the form on the reverse side of this page and identify which study periods you would like to nominate. You will then need to discuss this with your EPQ teacher and form tutor. We will then confirm when you can start to use your pass, until then you are expected to be in school full time.
