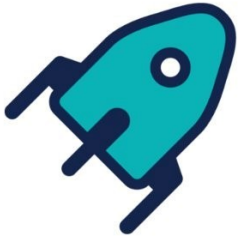


Oxfordshire's skills based virtual work experience programme

Springpod create virtual work experience programmes to connect students with top employers in the UK. Working with Oxfordshire Local Enterprise Partnership, they are running a programme that will bring to life the Oxfordshire Labour Market as well as helping students understand and develop the key skills that employers are looking for.

The programme will include activities where students need to submit work, and quizzes to check their understanding. There will also be live webinars with a range of employers which will include Q&A sessions. These will take place between **5 - 6pm** each evening from **Monday 5th July to Thursday 8th July**. If students are unable to attend the webinars, recordings will be available shortly afterwards. During the week, students will be required to complete **10-12 hours** of work.



The programme will cover:

- ◆ **Understanding the Oxfordshire Labour Market** – insight into the main business sectors and key employers in the county
- ◆ **Becoming employable** – hear from employers and apprentices about the skills essential to success in the workplace
- ◆ **Project management** – students will have the opportunity to complete an activity and hear from house builders St Modwen
- ◆ **Preparing for the world of work** – practical advice on applications, CVs and interviews, hear from key employers in Oxfordshire about their recruitment processes
