Information for Parents about our Four Day Experience

We look forward to welcoming your son/daughter to school for our Four Day Experience from Monday 4th July to Thursday 7th July 2022. Your son/daughter should arrive between 8:20 am and 8.40 am each day and will be met on the playground by our tutor team staff. The school day finishes at 3.20 pm, except for Wednesdays, when the school day ends at 2.20 pm.

What should my child wear?

Children should wear their primary school uniform each day.

What equipment does my child need to bring with them?

They will need a school bag containing a pencil case with pens, pencils etc and a water bottle. Each child should also bring a PE kit on the first day – after the first day they will be told whether they need a PE kit again, as this varies depending on which group each child is asked to join.

What will my child eat at lunch time?

The children will eat together in the school hall and each child may decide whether to bring a packed lunch, or choose a school dinner. Food for each day needs to be paid for in advance via the school online shop which can be found on our website under the heading 'Our School'. The daily spend limit for break and lunch is £4. Any unused funds will be carried over to September.

This payment facility will be available from Thursday 23rd June until Thursday 30th June and is only for the Four Day Experience. We will send you separate login information, following the Four Day Experience, with details on how to use ParentPay from September.

Travel to school for the Four Day Experience

Children may enter school on foot via either the Addison Road or Springfield Road entrances.

There is an area at school where a bicycle can be locked up for the day. We can direct your child there if they choose to arrive by bicycle. Cyclists should dismount and wheel their bicycle along once they are on the school site.

If you are dropping your child at school by car please do not enter Addison Road at any time, morning or evening, and please park considerately. Please also observe the no stopping zone at the Springfield Road entrance to school. Many parents choose to find parking on nearby streets and then walk to the gate to meet their child, or agree another meeting place away from the congestion and traffic.

Travel by Bus
